

Cost: \$90




Instructor: Coach Mona

This is a beginners volleyball class. Kids will be taught basic fundamentals for moving to the ball, passing, and under hand serving. We will learn the rules for how to play volleyball. New skills will be taught weekly. Kids will pair off to practice skill drills along with active drills with the coach. No experience is required but kids are expected to have a good attitude. The class will be runned like a club volleyball team practice with stretching, conditioning, and moving a lot! Any child with any health conditions should be aware of such physical activities. Kids will need to wear proper athletic shoes and proper attire that allows them to move. Parents will need to buy their child a pair of volleyball knee pads. The coach will give the option to buy a volleyball from her

(\$15 payable directly to the coach) to use and keep afterwards or you can buy a soft youth indoor volleyball for the class. The Coach will have a couple of extra balls and those who don't have one will have to share balls and reduce their hands on time as a result.

About the coach: Mona loves the game of volleyball and has played most of her life. She has coached Club (12U), girls middle school, and boys and girls high school volleyball teams. She enjoys teaching young players to play and gain self confidence, learn sportsmanship, and love the game of volleyball
